ACT composite score of 22 or above **OR** Evidence of Future Success. Expository Writing I and II with a grade of "C" or better in each course. Public Speaking with a grade of "C" or better. Completion of Early field experience (EDCI 230). Six hours of math with a minimum grade of "C" to include College Algebra or a higher level math course and STAT 325 or a higher level statistics course. 50 semester hours for Music Education students. Overall GPA of 2.75 Teaching field GPA of 2.75 Application for admission to teacher education to be prepared when all of the above are completed. DEADLINES: October 1 for Spring semester and February 15 for Fall semester.

Required for the Professional Semester (Student Teaching)

"Student Teacher Assignment Request" (STAR) form due September 1 or February 1 — the semester prior to student teaching.

American Red Cross or equivalent First Aid and CPR certification required at the time the STAR form is submitted.

Negative TB Test is required at the time of STAR Form Submission

Professional and Educational Service Hours due April 1 or November 1 of the semester before you student teach.

Admission to the Professional Semester (student teaching). (You will receive a student teaching license prior to student teaching.)
