Tenable	Use with existing programs and exchanges. Any destination abroad, that has a Department of State Travel Warning of 1 or 2.
Number & Amount	Number unknown. Up to \$5000 (based on need and program cost).
Duration	Apply to summer, semester or academic year programs. Must spend at least three weeks in one country.
Eligibility	
	Dependent child of an active duty military member(s) during the time of application in one of the following branches: Air Force, Army, Marine Corps, Navy, and Coase Guard US citizen. Any major. Recipient of any type of Title IV federal financial aid.
When	Any undergraduate year. Coordinate with plans for study abroad.
Selection Criteria	Strong essays. Appealing proposal for service project. Gilman-McCain also seeks diversity of academic major, destination and demography (both ethnic and geographic). Study outside of Western Europe/Australia is encouraged.
Campus Deadline	Financial Aid <i>and</i> Office of International Programs each must submit supplemental forms after you submit your Gilman-McCain application. They have a slightly later deadline.
Deadline	Fall deadline for Spring. Spring deadline for the following Summer or Fall. Early decision deadline in Fall for the following summer, fall or academic year.
Application	Apply online. Application form. Two essays: Statement of Purpose / Follow- On Project Proposal. Financial aid form (by FA advisor). Education abroad form (by EA advisor). Uploaded transcripts.
