

FULBRIGHT Students

Congratulations on being selected to study via the Fulbright scholarship!

The Sponsored Students Office will assist you in working with your *Institute for International Education* (IIE) AMIDEAST, or *Academic and Professional Programs for the Americas* (LASPAU) academic advisor and tuition departments.

All sponsored international students are required to sign the [Billing and Information Release form](#) in order for us to work with your sponsor on your behalf.

Important terms of your scholarship:

- **Online and hybrid** (part online, part in-person) **courses** are not allowed by your scholarship.
- **Housing** charges will appear in your student account if you live on campus. You can pay the charges online through your kSIS student account or in-person at 211 Anderson Hall.
- **Health insurance** is provided by United Healthcare as part of your scholarship. The charge for insurance will be billed to IIE or LASPAU. Vision and dental is not included, but a discount program is available.
- **Verifications** you may need:
 - Transcript of academic grades – order online at http://www.k-state.edu/registrar/t_v/ and request an electronic transcript sent to you and / or paper transcripts to be mailed.
 - Proof of enrollment – Registrar's Office, 118 Anderson Hall
 - Letter of verification - The Sponsored Student Office will help you with all other letters of verification.
- The Sponsored Student Office will help to monitor the number of credits completed with a tuition differential scholarship from Kansas State University, as well as the number of credits completed sponsored by your Fulbright scholarship.

Speak to your sponsorship advisor if you need to take an online class. Most scholarships do not permit online coursework without prior authorization. Charges for online class will stay in your student account until authorization is received in the Special Programs/Sponsored Students office.
