Congratulations on being selected to study via a Saudi Arabian scholarship!

Students sponsored by the Saudi Arabian Cultural Mission (SACM) may receive the King Abdullah Scholarship or a ministry, governmental agency or university scholarship. www.sacm.org

The Sponsored Students Office will assist you in working with your SACM advisor and the SACM tuition department.

All sponsored international students are required to sign the [Billing and Information Release form in order for us to work with your sponsor on your behalf.](#)

Important terms of your scholarship:

- **Course schedule** must be approved by your SACM advisor. Upload a copy to your SACM student portal when you enroll.
- **Online or hybrid courses** are not allowed. Special permission may be given for up to 12 credits (undergraduates) or 6 credits (graduate). Raise a request for online course on your SACM student portal BEFORE you enroll in the class. The bill for the class stays in your account until a special Financial Guarantee is issued to the Sponsored Student office.
- **Extend scholarship** by raising a request in the SACM student portal. English Language financial guarantees are valid for 6 months; most academic scholarships are valid for one year. Raise a request to extend your scholarship 30 days before it expires.
- **Health insurance** is provided by SACM if you have the full scholarship. The SPSS Office will work with the International Student and Scholar Services office (ISSS) to waive insurance if an active financial guarantee is on file. Student is responsible to be sure the insurance is waived.
- **ELP Students** on full scholarship are supported for 12 months. SACM requires:
 - 5.0 on the IELTS, or above 34 on the internet based TOEFL to request a 6-month extension.
 - attend 20 credits of English Language
 - attend 90% of classes to pass
- **Verifications** you may need:
 - Transcript of academic grades – order online at http://www.k-state.edu/registrar/t_v/
 - Proof of enrollment – order online http://www.k-state.edu/registrar/t_v/verify.html or in person at the Registrar’s Office 118 Anderson Hall
 - English Language Program progress report or grade report can be printed from your KSU KSIS K-State Online account. SACM will require this report at the end of each semester.
 - Letters of verification: The Sponsored Student Office will help you with all other letters of verification.
