Gender, Women and Sexuality Studies	2012	05.0207	B	ICP	Enhance	Even though the program is interdisciplinary, the program's junior/senior fall enrollment continues to decline with only 16 enrolled for Fall 2016 resulting in a five –year average of 18. Changes to the degree program name to be more inclusive of other marginalized groups, may create more interest for this program. However, the minor program has a five-year average of 47. In addition, the degrees conferred has fallen below a five-year average of 10. Formal review of this program was just completed in 2013 and will not be reviewed again until 2022
Professional Master Of Technology	2015	15.9999	M	MPI	Enhance	Still a fairly new program; started in fall 2011. For the past two years, 12 master's students have enrolled increasing the five-year average to eight. This is an interdisciplinary program. Even with increased enrollment, the five-year average number of degrees conferred is still zero. Formal review recommended in two years.
