Fiscal Implications of the Results of Program Review 2022

The 30 programs reviewed for the 2022 cycle resulted in 30 being recommended to Continue, 0 for Enhance, and 0 for Additional Review. In addition, we recommend that the one program that was under additional review Continue, with an additional review in fall 2022. We believe that all programs recommended for Continue are funded, through tuition revenue and general funds, to the extent necessary to maintain their quality as well as support the degrees awarded in their present structure. These programs represent a number of strong majors in the university and attract generally strong pools of students to them. The departments and colleges represented operate efficiently in the use of teaching resources for all classes offered for the represented majors.

Under our new budget model, colleges will be monitoring all programs relative to not only KBOR minimum expectations for graduates and enrollments, but also whether the programs can be feasibly supported going into the future.
