## Credit: 1-6 hours on a credit/no credit basis

- All majors welcome to take the course!
- Prerequisites: consent of internship coordinator and 1 POLSC course
- Minimum of 50 hours of work must be completed for each credit hour of the internship (ex. 150 hours = 3 credit hours)
- Up to 6 hours can be applied to Political Science major or 3 hours for the minor
- Additional course components: reading appropriate to the internship position, evaluation letter from field supervisor, and final assessment paper.
- Note: Credit cannot be arranged after an interhnship is completed.
   Plan ahead!
