- ▶ **LANDON LECTURE SERIES**, with a best-selling author and CNN political pundits delivering lectures earlier this month, and the vice chairman and chief scientific officer of PepsiCo next up on **April 25**, followed by the president of Costa Rica on **May 19**.
- ▶ **THE ALL-UNIVERSITY OPEN HOUSE, April 16**, allowed visitors and students to dig into their purple roots.
- ▶ **THE GRADUATE RESEARCH, ARTS AND DISCOVERY — or GRAD — Forum** took place on **March 30**, highlighting exemplary graduate-level work.
- ▶ **K-STATE SPRING GAME**, the annual football scrimmage, on **April 23**.
- ▶ **THE BERNEY FAMILY WELCOME CENTER**, being created through renovations on the east side of historic Memorial Stadium, is scheduled to open in **May**.
- ▶ **COMMENCEMENT** will be **May 7, 13 and 14**, adding to the ever-growing K-State alumni base.
