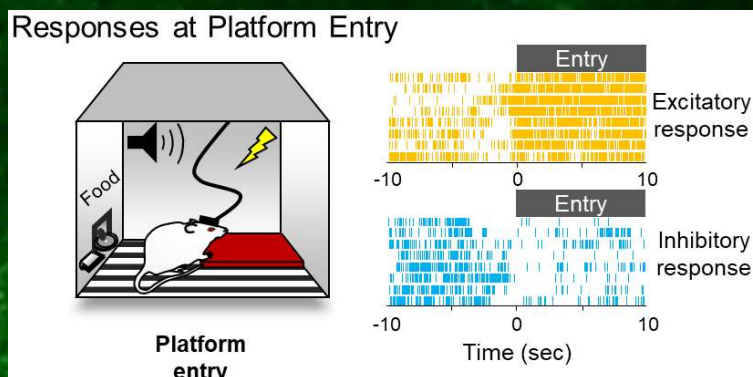


The Diehl Lab is looking for talented students to join our team!

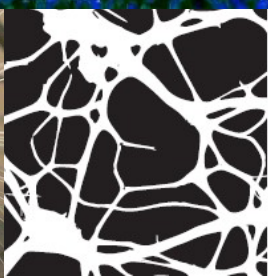
