

Fall 2018 FDA and USRG Request for Proposals
(Deadline: 5:00 pm, Monday, October 1, 2018)

The Office of Research Development announces the fall 2018 FDA and USRG Call for Proposals for Kansas State University tenured or tenure-track faculty who are interested in receiving assistance in their scholarly activities and professional development. Note: faculty must have at least some percentage of their appointment devoted to research.

The President's **Faculty Development Awards (FDA)** program provides support for travel to international meetings (primarily at international locations) or to meet with program officers from potential external sponsors.

The **University Small Research Grants (USRG)** program is a "seed" grant program to support early research, scholarly activity, and other creative efforts.

If you seek support for travel/projects occurring **between January 1, 2019 and June 30, 2019** apply in this competition. For travel/ projects occurring between **July 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019**, apply in the **spring 2019 competition** (due date March 4, 2019).
