Summer Financial Aid Policies

- You must be enrolled in your summer courses before aid will be offered to you.
 - Minimum enrollment requirements to be eligible for financial aid
 - 5 credit hours** for Undergraduate students
 - 3 credit hours** for Graduate students
 - 5 credit hours** for Veterinary Medicine
- Important:** If students your summer enrollment changes after your summer financial aid has already been disbursed, federal regulations may require the University to bill you for all or a portion of the summer financial aid that you already received. Consequently, we urge you to consult with our office before making any summer enrollment changes.
- To determine your financial aid eligibility, you must have a 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with our office.

Additional Summer Financial Aid Considerations (check all that apply)

- I plan to study abroad. Please schedule an appointment with your financial aid advisor if you need financial aid for your study abroad trip.
