POSTER GUIDELINES

Each subaward PI should utilize the poster (<u>linked here</u>) to display the project's innovations and/or technologies as it relates to the Sustainable Intensification Assessment Framework and the systems approach. For example, you could select one innovation and/or technology, and talk about its evolution over the years, overall conclusions, and how the innovation and/or technology might be scaled up in the future.

Please utilize the provided template to design your poster. All posters must be emailed as a PowerPoint file to <u>Andra Williams</u> with a cc to <u>Dr. Vara Prasad</u> and <u>Dr. Jan Middendorf</u> by **Friday, March 15, 2019**. The SIIL team will print your poster for you.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Each subaward PI (or representative) should prepare for a **25-minute** presentation followed by a 5-minute Q&A session. The following topics should be addressed in the presentation, and the number of suggested slides per topic is provided. The presentation template is available on our website's Resources section and is also <u>linked here</u>.

- Introduction and objectives (1-2)
- Critical Innovation(s) and/or Technologies (1-2)
- Suitability of Innovation(s) and/or Technologies (5-6)
- Overall outcomes of your Research Project (4-6)
- Data Management (i.e. data uploaded, current status, and future plans) (1)
- Scalability and Sustainability of Innovation(s) and/or Technologies (1-2)
- Future Research Directions (1-2)
- Acknowledgement of <u>all</u> partners
