Sigma Lambda Gamma and Alpha Kappa Alpha traded in their pink for the day to go red to raise heart health awareness!



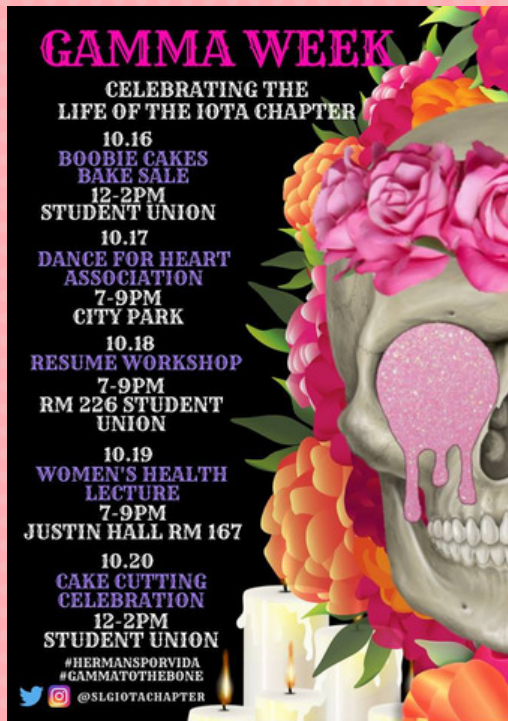
DELTA SIGMA THETA GALA

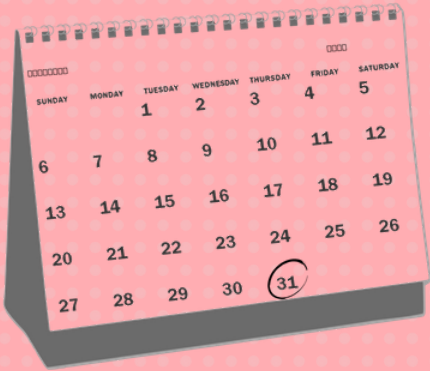
