Since its inception, Forsyth Country Club has been distinguished as one of the premier clubs in the South. The Club is nestled on 172 acres of pristine rolling hills in Winston-Salem, NC. A major course renovation project was completed in 2018 that included:

- Greens conversion from A1/A4 Bentgrass to Champion Ultradwarf Bermudagrass
- Re-grassing of collars and approaches
- All bunkers renovated using the Better Billy Bunker method
- Greens and Perimeter irrigation upgrade to Toro Infinity heads
- Pond reconstruction

- Assist in managing a staff of 22-24 employees.
- Apply fertilizers and pesticides.
- Irrigation troubleshooting / repair.
- Record keeping.

- Associate Degree required, Bachelor's Degree preferred in Turf Management.
- NC Pesticide Applicators License or the ability to obtain one within 6 months of hire.
- Ability to lift at least 50 lbs and be able to perform repetitive motions.
- Ability to work in all weather conditions.
