POSITION DETAILS/THE GOLF COURSE

Woodmont Country Club is seeking an Assistant Superintendent to be part of our management team. Those interested will have the opportunity to be part of a high energy, positive work environment that strives to create learning opportunities that prepare individuals for advancement in Golf Course Management.

Assistants will be involved in the daily management of either the North or South Course and will work closely with all members of the management team. Past Assistants have had the opportunity to manage tee constructions, building improvement projects, housing upgrades, green alterations, bunker renovations, and many other golf course improvement projects. Managing these types of projects and involvement in annual planning and budgeting has helped prepare Assistants make an easy transition into a Superintendents role.

Woodmont CC is a 36 hole private country club with two championship golf courses located just outside of Washington D.C. The North Course was built in 1951 and features A-4 USGA greens, Pennncross tees and fairways, and combination of Kentucky bluegrass/tall fescue rough. The North Course is currently in the process of a complete bunker renovation that also includes re-grassing approaches to 007 bentgrass, green complex adjustments, and fairway alterations.

The South Course was built in 1955 and features Meyer zoysiagrass fairways and push-up Poa/bent greens. A South Course master plan was developed which includes a full renovation of the golf course - greens, tees, fairways, bunkers and irrigation.

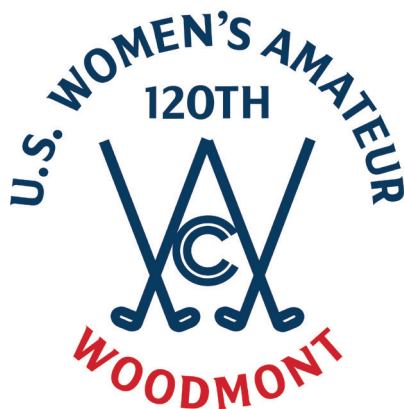
LISA BARTON

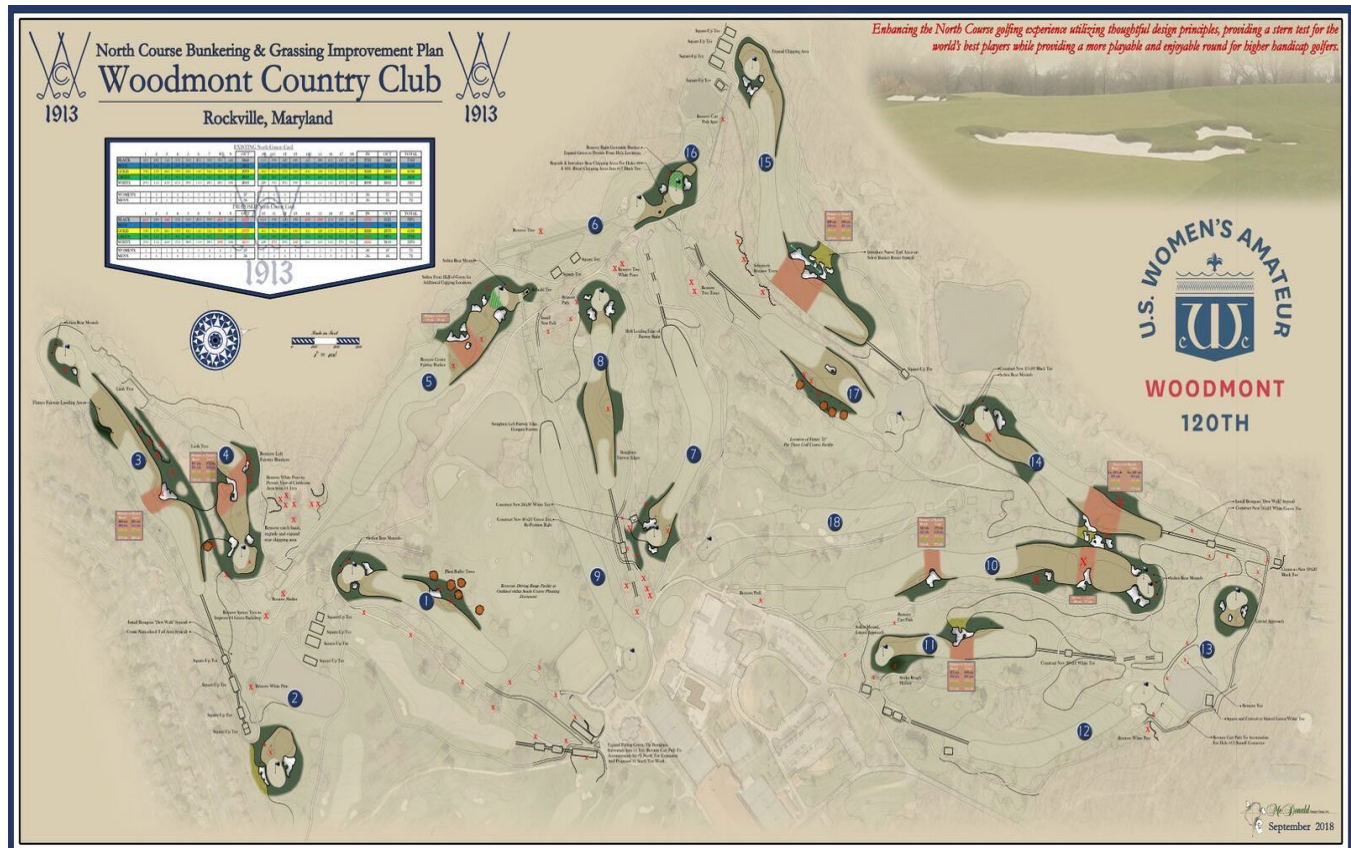

NORTH COURSE

Our championship golf course, The North Course, is the original 18 hole golf course in Rockville, and was designed and constructed by course architect Alfred Tull in 1950. The greens are USGA built with A-4 bentgrass and Penncross bentgrass from tee to fairway. In 1999, The North Course went through an extensive renovation, including replacement of the original 18 greens. The renovation was done by renowned course architect Arthur Hills. More recently, architect Joel Weiman is leading a complete bunker renovation that also includes green complex adjustments and some re-grassing.

SOUTH COURSE

On Labor Day of 1961, what is currently known as The South Course debuted. The South Course features the original push-up Poa/bentgrass greens and Meyer zoysiagrass fairways. The South Course is a fun, golfer friendly layout that is favored by much of the membership. A full-course renovation is on the horizon which includes a new irrigation system, vast expansion of the current zoysia fairways, all new bunkers, and re-grassing of the current greens.

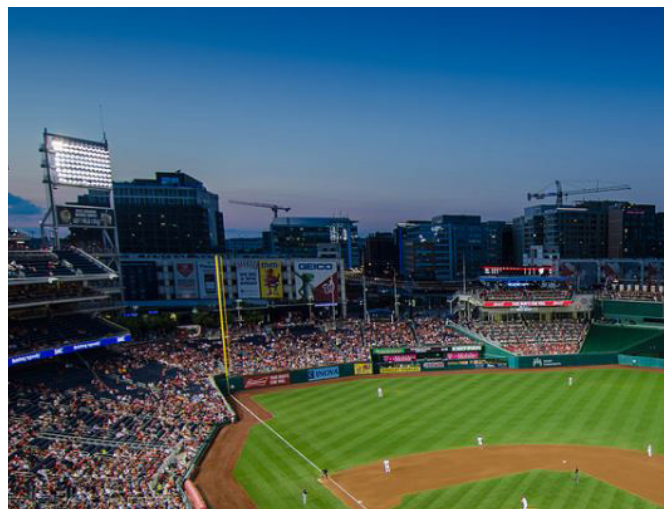
